

Resolutions adopted in the Uttarakhand Judges' Association General Body Meeting/Conference of the Association, held on 23rd February 2025, at Doon University Dehradun.

An Annual General Body Meeting/Conference of the Uttarakhand Judges' Association was held on 23rd February 2025, at Doon University Dehradun. The following resolutions were adopted after thorough discussion.

1. Regarding Amendment to the Constitution of the Uttaranchal Judges' Association- The following amendments to the Constitution of the Uttaranchal Judges' Association were passed by the General Body of the Association, and incorporated in the Constitution of the Uttaranchal Judges' Association:

(i) The word "Uttaranchal" appearing in various Articles and Clauses of the constitution of the Uttaranchal Judges' Association was amended to "Uttarakhand"

(ii) Amendment in Article 1-

The association shall be called the **Uttarakhand Judges' Association**. It shall have its head office at **Dehradun** and other offices at such places as may be decided by the Executive Committee or the President. **It shall be deemed to have come into effect from 15th November, 2024, when it was passed by the office bearers of the Association in its virtual meeting.**

(iii) Amendment in Article 6- Article 6 shall be omitted, and replaced by the following words:

A. Every member of the Association, who is in Service on 4 October 2024, shall pay one time subscription of Rs.12,000/-, till 7th January 2025.

It shall be deemed to have come into effect from 3rd November, 2024, when it was passed by the office bearers of the Association in its virtual meeting.

B. Every new member of the Association shall pay one time subscription of Rs.12,000/- within six months of joining the service.

C. Every member of the Association shall also pay Rs 6000 yearly(to be paid in till 31st March of every calendar year) as annual subscription for the Association.

D. All the subscription shall be paid directly to the Account of the Association through cheque or any online banking transaction mode.

E. Members shall inform about the payment of subscription to the Secretary of the District Unit in which he is posted. Secretary of the District Unit shall also inform the new members about the payment of subscription. Secretary of the District Unit shall also forward the information about payment of subscription to the treasurer of the Association. If any member of the association is posted on deputation within state or out of the state, he shall directly inform the treasurer about the status of payment of subscription.

F. The Executive Committee may change the rate of one time subscription and annual subscription or ask for additional subscription for special purposes.

(iv) Amendment in Article 7-

The following words shall be added after the Proviso

B. Conference of the Association shall be convened through physical mode.

Provided that, in case of emergency or in exceptional circumstances as decided by the Executive Committee, conference of the Association may be convened through Virtual mode also.

(v) Amendment in Article 8-

The following words shall be added after the existing provision

B. Meeting of the State Council may be convened through physical or Virtual mode as decided by the President.

(vi) Amendment in Article 9-

The following words shall be added in the existing provision, in clause (iii) “, **through physical or virtual mode,**” after the words “The Executive Committee shall meet” and before the words “at any time on a notice of three days to all its members by the Secretary General”,

Similarly, The following words shall be added in the proviso after clause (iii), “ **through physical or virtual mode,**” after the words “ Provided that an emergent meeting” and before the words “ of the Executive Committee may be called on a notice..”

Similarly, the following words shall be added in clause (iv), “ **/virtual mode**” after the words “ ...may be ascertained by correspondence ” and before the words “ by specified time limit and the majority opinion ...”

Similarly, the following words shall be added in clause (vi), “, **through physical or virtual mode,**” after the words “ ...in the requisition, the Secretary General shall convene the meeting ” and before the words “ of the Executive Committee within 14 days...”

(vii) Amendment in Article 10-

The following Clause ii-A shall be added after the existing clause ii,

ii-A. Eleven representative shall be as following:-

A. Five Judicial Officers, i.e. Principal Secretary, Law-cum-L.R. Govt. of Uttarakhand, Dehradun, Registrar General, High Court of Uttarakhand, Legal Advisor to H.E., the Governor of Uttarakhand, Principal Secretary, Legislative & Parliamentary Affairs, Government of Uttarakhand, Dehradun, District & Sessions Judge Dehradun, shall be ex officio representative for this purpose.

B. Six representatives shall be elected with the office-bearers, in the same manner as the office-bearers are elected.

For the current tenure, and to avoid unnecessary delay, the six representatives have been elected unanimously in the General Body meeting held on 23rd February, 2025, without following the aforementioned procedure.

Similarly, the following words shall be added in clause (iv), “ including representatives” after the words “ Name of the members seeking election for any post” and before the words “ should be proposed by one member ...”

(viii) Amendment in Article 11-

The following words shall be added in the existing clause 3 after the existing clause, “ ,**through physical or Virtual mode.**”

2. Regarding enactment of The Uttarakhand Judicial Officers’ Benevolent Fund Scheme, 2025-

The **The Uttarakhand Judicial Officers’ Benevolent Fund Scheme, 2025**, the final draft of which was shared by Senior Joint Secretary of the Association on the Whatsapp group of the Uttarakhand Judges’ Association, on 22.02.2025, was enacted by the General Body of the Uttarakhand Judges’ Association and it was resolved that it will come into force with immediate effect.

3. Regarding Online Medical Services by Doctors on Duty-

A presentation was given by the team of Doctors on Duty for providing online medical facilities, including online medical consultation, ambulance services for members in cases of emergency etc., and a two year subscription fee of Rs. 1,00,000/-, for the online medical services by Doctors on Duty was approved by the full house of the Uttarakhand Judges’ Association.
